

# Lasswade Archery Club

**Indoor Shooting - Procedure from 15 Sept 2021**

**Update 11 October 2021**

SA Regulations apply.

Lasswade Centre (LC) conditions apply.

## **Booking.**

Booking is no longer required due to rules being relaxed. Maximum number permitted is open including any non-shooting officials eg coach. This may change at a later date.

## **Arrival and Registration** (for Track and Trace)

All persons sign in and out at equipment cabinet.

## **Covid Restrictions**

Face masks at all times except when on the shooting line. Non-shooting participants will wear mask at all times.

Social distancing is to be maintained as per SA and LC requirements. Currently LC state reasonable distance. SA state reasonable distancing beyond Level 0. Club accept reasonable distance.

Hand Sanitiser should be used pre and after shooting (during if required)

## **Hall set up**

Targets set at 1.8m spacing. Therefore 9 total in the ½ hall

Shooting line and safety line is as previous indoor sessions. Shooting distance is 20yards or 18m.

Targets are put out and taken in by centre staff. Archers put out own faces.

Distance between safety line and the rear wall dictate no of archers permitted. LC have relaxed max numbers. Note this is for all age categories. This is subject to review.

No spectators in hall. 1 supervisor per child or vulnerable Adult will be permitted. These persons are included in our total number

A Coach is Permitted.

No kit bags etc. permitted behind shooting line. Kit bags must be stored along the sides of the hall.

Archers arriving or finishing whilst the session is in progress can prepare / pack away their kit in the storage area behind the roller doors.

## **Shooting**

Normal rules of shooting will take place, 4 archers per boss shooting in 2 waves of 2 archers where necessary.

Archers will collect their own arrows.
