FIELD ARCHERY SHOOT

PORTSMOUTH LEAGUE

Last year's popular event is being improved and extended for the coming winter. Competitors will shoot 8 indoor "Portsmouth" Rounds on 2 Sundays per month during November to March as members of teams, and medals and prizes will be awarded to the best overall seniors and juniors as well as top teams. Last year we had 4 teams of 4 and we would like to see this extended. These rounds are considered suitable for most archers except complete beginners.

Cost will be £2 total for the 8 events, juniors £1.

Competitors should be aware that this is a team activity and their fellow team members will be relying on them to turn up and shoot on each of the 8 Sunday mornings.

The more entries we get the more prizes we can afford. Please add your name to the Activity List on the notice board, so that arrangements can be finalised.

WINTER PROGRAMME

In general we will shoot a "Portsmouth"

Wednesday evenings will generally be for practice but will be available for FITA Rounds if desired. We propose a special coaching session on the third Wednesday of each month from September, at which that more experienced archers will assist newer members. We also hope to invite one or 2 International archers to give talks and coaching at these sessions.

CLUB RECORDS

The gents outdoor record list will be extended for 1984 to include: "York", "New Western" and "Long Metric" Rounds.

In future, only scores obtained during tournaments will be eligible for consideration as club records. A tournament means an event at which prizes or trophies are awarded, whether Open or Confined. The reason for this is that we feel that competitors are under greater pressure in these events and we therefore have to exclude practice rounds from consideration.

FACE FEES

Unfortunately we have to increase these slightly to 30p from 1 September because of increased Hall rental.
