DAY - 1

Day one was the Fita section of this shoot with Lasswade represented by Tina and Andy. The weather was wet and windy.

By the end of the day Tina's score of 910 earned her 6th place for the ladies recurve. She also continued to add to her tally of distance medals by shooting a 243 at 70 metres. Young Andy's score of 946 secured him third in the gents compound group.

DAY - 2

The Masters shoot on the Sunday saw dry and bright weather making a welcome return. The distances shot were 60, 50 and 40 metres with various target faces being used.

Meg was our only lady recurve taking 13th place with a 528. Bill C, our only recurve gent, scored 757 to take 7th place.

Andy was joined by "that other Bill", Bill M in the gents compound group. A 761 earned Andy 4th place and Bill M's score of 740 gave him 5th.

Five of our archers made the journey north with the "dynamic due" of Bill M and Derek there again as two of the judges.
