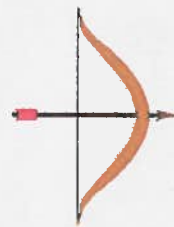

Scottish Disability Sports Championships - Lasswade 20 November 1999

Once again Lasswade will be providing the venue for the above shoot and Andy will be the organiser. Due to the various disabilities of the archers it would be appreciated if some of you could assist in setting up the range as well as undertaking scoring duties and pulling arrows. If you can help out then please be at the centre for 12 noon for a 1pm start.

Lasswade European Indoor Internet league

In addition to the normal league we shoot during the indoor season, Joan will be organising this league which will involve us shooting against European clubs as well as those in the UK. As our foreign competitors do not shoot imperial rounds such as a Portsmouth, the accepted found will be an 18m Fita, that's the one with the small 40cm face. This will mean that two Wednesdays per month will need to be set aside, one for the SAA. League's Portsmouth and the other for the European 18m Fita. At all postal shoots, especially the Fita,

can you please come along sharp so we can get the rounds shot in the time allowed, it may be necessary to shoot four arrow ends. In other words, if you are set up, please help get the faces pinned onto the Bosses. Don't stand around expecting other people to do it for you. There is little point in shooting these rounds if we are rushed into completing them. I propose we shoot our normal Portsmouth round on the 3rd November and the Fita on the 17th

The team formats for the leagues will be as follows :

SAA - The top four recurves will form the 1st team and the next four the 2nd team.

The top two compounds will form the 1st team the next two the 2nd team etc.

The number of teams entered will depend on how many of us shoot the November round

EUROPEAN - There will be one recurve team consisting of the top five scores and one compound team again of the top five scores.

Joan has also suggested that our less able juniors could shoot a ten yard version of the round, so juniors, speak up if you have any objections.
