#### GNAS/SAA/Area Affiliation Fees 2003/2004

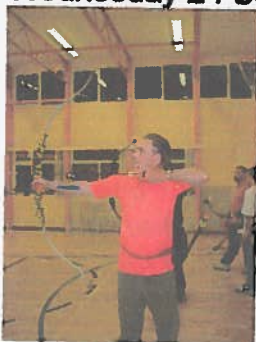

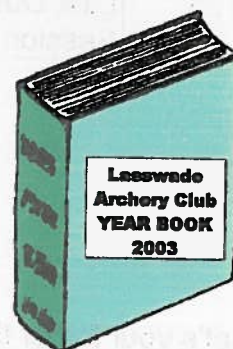
#### SAA Yearbook

In addition I also have copies of the new SAA Constitution and the Disciplinary Regulations. Club only copies will be put up on our

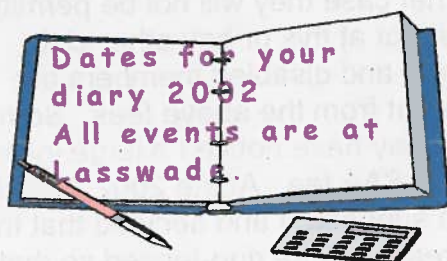


noticeboard in the Sports Centre and if you want a copy then see me.

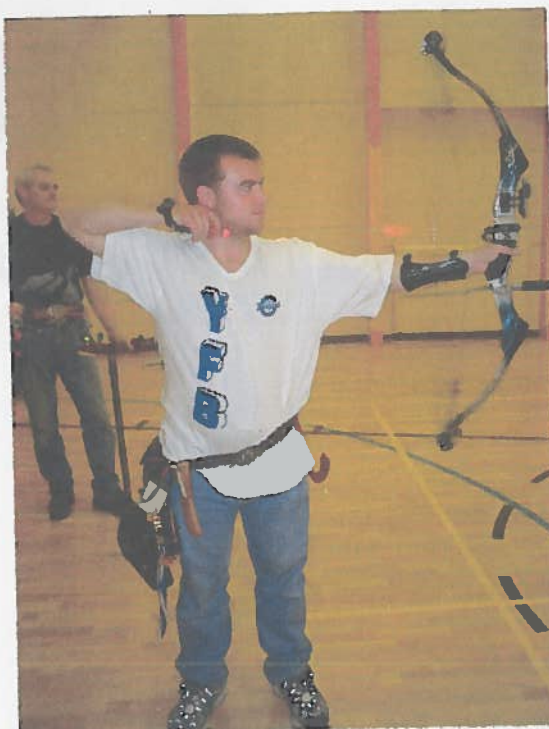
