(810) Penicuik – 31st August 2003.

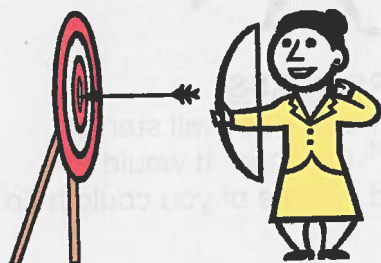
This year's event was attended by 6 of us and the American round was shot once again, 2½ dozen arrows (each) at 60,50 and 40 yards.

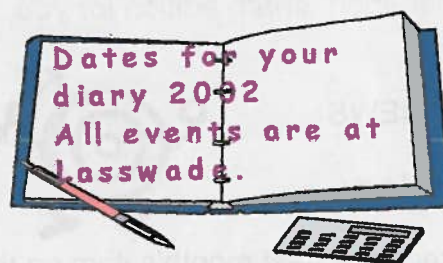
