LASSWADE ARCHERY CLUB 27TH ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

One of the main topics to be discussed will
be the sharp rise in Club Membership fees.
Various ideas which will be debated will be
a straight increase of the fees, cancellation
of Wednesday or Saturday indoor sessions
or a one-off payment which all members
would pay to cover all field/hall hire and
target fees for a season or whole year.
I must stress that these are only ideas but
due to the poor attendances during the
outdoor season and ridiculous field - hire
charges we have made a large loss. Put

simply, the current Club fees are also too
low or put another way a Junior is only
paying 21p. per week and a senior member
is paying just 42p. per week in Club fees.
Which - ever option is decided upon a
decision will have to be made on the night
regardless of how many of you attend.
Finally, three things for you to remember
Under article 22c of the Club's Constitution
only those members who attend are entitled
to vote.

Secondly, under article 22d the Club
President shall, if required, be entitled to cast
one additional vote in the event of any tied
votes.

Thirdly, there will be NO CLUB SESSION
THAT NIGHT.
