Not a lot of news to report this month.

CLUB NEWS

GNAS /SAA / E. Area Affiliation Fees for 2006 / 07.

Once again we have reached the time when our affiliation fees are due. The fees, which are unchanged from last year are as follows:- GNAS - £30, SAA - £21, and E.Area - £1 This means that each senior member will pay £52 and each Junior will pay £10 for GNAS and SAA.

All payments should be made by a cheque made payable to Lasswade Archery Club with the cheques given to me. As all the fees have to be sent to GNAS by 31st October, all payments must be received by me no later than Saturday 16th September.

Once I have received your fees I will then issue you with your new GNAS sticker for 2006 / 07. If your fees are not returned by the above date then you will not be issued with your new sticker and your name will be deleted from the affiliation list, which has to be sent to GNAS. It will also be illegal for you to shoot at any GNAS Club or participate at any tournament.

To all disabled members.

The committee has decided that as with the junior club all disabled members will pay a share of the block fee for the disabled club members, which is £42.50p. Therefore our 3 disabled members will pay £14 each towards the block affiliation fee.

If one member does not pay then the remaining members will pay the full £52 as a disabled club must have at least 3 members in any one season.
