AFFILIATION FEES UP-DATE

Now that the AGM season is over I can now advise you that the fees have been increased by £1-00p (GNAS) and £2-00p. (SAA) The Eastern Area fee remains at £1

This means that the fees for 2008/09 will be as follows:-
