AGB FEES FOR 2017/2018

Nothing for you to be concerned about for some time yet.

At the AGB AGM, one of the main proposals which was approved, was that the Affiliation Fees will be increased by £2.00 across most categories of Club Senior, Junior and Disabled Members and they are effective from the 1st October this year. Any new members joining before then will continue to pay the current fees in force although this will be at the rate of a 50% discount on the full annual fees currently payable.

The Scottish Archery and Eastern Area fees will remain un-changed at their levels though again, any new members joining until then will also pay a reduced fee.

Nearer the time, I will go over the new fees and who will pay what at the time the request is made to all members for the appropriate amounts.

For the benefit of our newer members, please remember that un-like your Club Fees, the amounts requested must be made as a one-off payment only as you cannot pay these fees by instalments.
